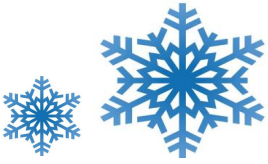

SHOW DONOR INFORMATION

Our Annual art show provides cash awards and ribbons to twenty five artists in addition to our drawing, which provides Scholarship monies for students. We give five hundred dollars to the best of show winner and eight prize monies to first, second, and third place winners. First place winners receive one hundred dollars each, second place winners receive eighty do dollars each and third place winners receive sixty dollars each. This money comes from yearly donors who have supported our Art League for thirty one years. We look for new donors and gratefully accept all donations. Donors receive a handwritten thank you note upon receipt of the donation and a framed certificate after the show, personally delivered whenever possible. In addition, donors' names are placed on a board at the show and are named in our directory.

Please consider donating and know that all money awards the artists for their efforts and talents. We do not use the money for our expenses at all. We have a fine core of donors and would be delighted for new members or others to join in our awarding of artistic talent to show people who work so hard to foster a fine art show.
